PREFACE

Since its premiere in 2005, the **PDC Premier League** has been regarded as one of the most important tournaments in the darts calendar - right behind the World Championship. Week after week, this prestigious event tours Europe's major arenas, offering fans top-class matches, a thrilling stage atmosphere and unforgettable moments. Unlike traditional ranking tournaments, qualification for the Premier League is not automatically based on sporting performance alone - only the top four in the PDC Order of Merit receive an automatic invitation. There are also four "wildcards", which are awarded by the PDC. The criteria - performance, popularity and media presence - regularly lead to heated discussions before the start of the series.

The temporary introduction of the "Contender" in the Premier League was mainly to provide more variety and appeal. Local stars and young talents were to create additional excitement and build an emotional connection with the audience. The PDC also used the concept to specifically promote young talent by giving up-and-coming players such as Nathan Aspinall or Luke Humphries the chance to compete against the elite at an early stage. Contenders were also often selected based on location - such as John Henderson in Aberdeen or Chris Dobey in Newcastle - to reinforce the regional feel. The selection included three groups: local heroes (e.g. Willie O'Connor in Dublin), young talent (such as Max Hopp in Berlin) and cult figures and surprise candidates, including Fallon Sherrock, the first woman to play in the Premier League. This made for unforgettable moments and strengthened the bond between the tournament and the fans.



Since 2022, the Premier League has been played in a "mini-tournament" format: on each of the 16 match days, the eight invited players compete against each other in a knockout system - first in the quarter-finals, then in the semi-finals and final. Each evening therefore produces a daily winner who secures valuable points for the overall standings. In addition, the losing semi-finalists and finalists also receive points, which ensures a high level of suspense throughout the ranking. At the end of the regular match days, the four players with the most points qualify for the play-offs, where the Premier League champion is crowned in the semi-finals and final.

PREFACE

This dynamic format combines a tournament format with a league system - a unique mix that guarantees top-class matches week after week.

The list of previous winners is particularly impressive: Phil Taylor won the first edition in 2005 and has won the title a total of six times. However, the record winner is Michael van Gerwen with seven titles to date. Gary Anderson, Raymond van Barneveld, Glen Durrant, Jonny Clayton and the absolute shooting star Luke Littler are also among the winners of this elite tournament. Luke Humphries recently secured his first Premier League title in the 2025 season in London - in a high-class final against Luke Littler with an 11:8 victory, and of course the famous 9-darter - the perfect leg with just nine darts - is a must in Premier League history. This feat has been achieved a total of 16 times to date - five of them in the 2025 season alone - a record that underlines the special quality of this competition.

... are the basic structure of every collection, as the standard set to collect. A completion of all base cards is called a base set. The scope of the base set varies depending on the thematic focus and overall scope of the respective collection.

For our exclusive PDC Premier League Darts Collection it made sense to create a special historical reference: that's why we have included in the base set all players who have officially participated in the PDC Premier League since its foundation in 2005 - players who were part of the classification, be it as seeded starters or nominated by a wildcard. The result is a unique set of 41 base cards that covers the entire history of the Premier League up to and including the 2025 season. This base set is therefore not only the foundation of the collection, but also a living archive of one of the most important darts events.

Depending on when your love of darts began, you will rediscover players who may no longer be in the limelight today - but whose importance to the development of the sport remains unforgotten.

Parallel Cards

For each of the 41 base cards in the Premier League collection, there are also matching parallel cards - i.e. variants with an identical motif but a special visual finish. Parallel cards have long since established themselves as real highlights in the collectors' scene, as they combine the design with modified colours, elegant foiling and a high rarity value.

In contrast to the regular base cards, many of these variants are strictly limited and numbered: a card with the number "1/25", for example, indicates that there are only 25 of this variant in the world - and that you yourself own the first one. These cards are particularly coveted by collectors and make hunting, swapping and completing them an exciting experience.

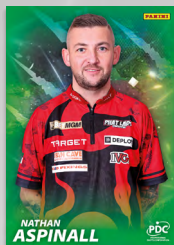

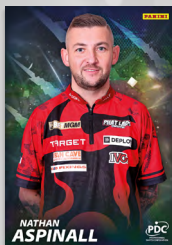

Whether you're collecting specific colours or want to secure every existing version of your favourite players, the Parallel Cards offer you the perfect stage to customise your collection and hold your personal Premier League moment in your hands.

Parallel Cards - Box Hit

What is a Box Hit?

The Pink Cracked Ice Cards play a special role in the Parallels: they are not numbered, but their eye-catching design and exclusive availability make them a real highlight for collectors. On average, there are two of these cards per box. Such cards are known as box hits. The term stands for particularly attractive contents that are not included in every pack, but typically in every box - and therefore make up the special attraction when opening.

Box Hit thus denotes a particularly attractive and collectible card that is typically included once per box - regardless of which individual cards are included in the packs.

The frequency of these cards is based on the print run of the respective box containing the hit. This means that the smaller the total print run of the boxes, the less frequently the respective box hit is in circulation.



Insert Cards

... are special cards that clearly stand out from the base cards in terms of design and content. They are divided into thematic categories, each relating to specific player profiles, historical moments or special Premier League highlights, each of which offers a unique collecting experience - from legends of the sport to current stars and spectacular match moments. Some inserts are more common, others much rarer - which makes them particularly coveted among collectors.

There are also additional parallel versions of the insert cards, which differ in terms of special colors, foil finishes or limited editions. This visual and content diversity creates additional excitement when opening the packs - and gives collectors the opportunity to add exclusive variants to their collection. Below we present the insert categories of this collection in detail.

CONTENDERS

Some Premier League stories don't start with a permanent place in the starting line-up - but with a one-off opportunity. Contenders were players who were nominated to replace Gary Anderson, who retired due to injury in 2019, and were therefore allowed to compete on individual Premier League match days. In 2020, the Contenders were incorporated into the Premier League format as a permanent fixture for one year.

Whether young talent, local crowd favourite or future world champion: between 2019 and 2020, a total of 14 players were given the opportunity to prove themselves on the big stage - albeit without any influence on the official standings. This category is dedicated to all those who played their way into the limelight as Contenders and left a lasting impression with their performances. Players such as Glen Durrant, Luke Humphries, Max Hopp and Fallon Sherrock not only used the stage for self-expression - they also played a decisive role in shaping the format with their energy, emotionality and fan loyalty. These cards are a tribute to the courage, talent and special history of those players who were only there temporarily - but whose performance remains unforgettable for many fans.

Whether it’s Phil Taylor’s legendary “I’ve Got The Power” thundering through the halls like a battle cry, or the electrifying presence of Michael van Gerwen marching through the spotlight, each of these cards captures a moment when the player doesn’t just take the stage, but claims it for himself. For all those who not only play or collect darts - but also feel them.

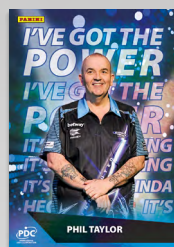

TIMELESS MOMENTS

There are moments in darts that go beyond numbers, victories or statistics - they burn themselves into the memory and become emotional landmarks for an entire generation of fans. The Premier League has produced many such moments over the last two decades - moments that have made history and will forever be associated with the legend of this tournament series.

Like Phil Taylor's legendary final in 2010, in which he was the only player to date to throw two nine-darters in one match - a moment for the ages, even if it were to be repeated one day. Or Michael van Gerwen's exceptional performance in 2016, when he played a game with an average of 123.40 points at a level that is still considered an unrivalled benchmark today. But unforgettable moments are not only created at the oche: when John Henderson played his walk-on with two bagpipers in Glasgow in 2019, the hall was turned upside down. A local hero, cheered on by the crowd, accompanied by the sound of Scottish tradition - a goosebump moment that proves that darts is not just a sport, but also pure emotion.

PORTRAIT LIGHTNING

This high-quality insert category visualises the exciting interplay of the Premier League with clearly divided portraits and contrasts: the run of a player on one evening and his influence on the ranking. The design reflects the two sides of the game: one player can leave the stage as the winner, while another fails in the quarter-finals - one evening, two completely different stories.

This was already a central motif of the Portrait-Lightning category in the 2025 season: every evening creates stories - with players at the peak of their performance and others having a difficult run. These cards highlight precisely this contrast - celebrating brilliant performances, recalling setbacks and capturing just how intense, emotional and high-class a Premier League matchday can be. A key feature: since the change in format with the launch of the mini-knockout system in 2022, there are no more draws. Previously, matches occasionally ended 6:6 - an important difference in the scoring system at the time. In the current tournament mode, every match has to be decided and there is a clear winner at the end of the evening - an element of tension that these inserts capture graphically.

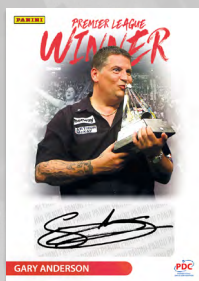

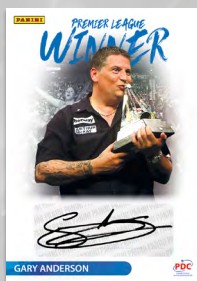
WINNER Autographs

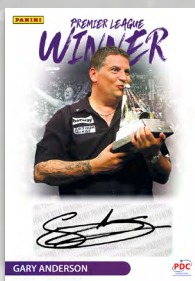

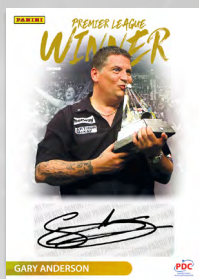

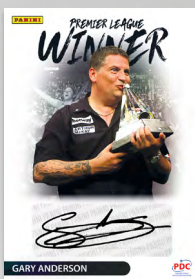

TRADING CARD ACCESSORIES

Collecting trading cards is more than just a hobby – it's a passion. To preserve the value and quality of your cards, the right accessories are essential. We provide you with an overview of the most important accessories for beginners and their use:

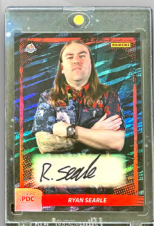


1. Sleeves – Basic protection for every card

Sleeves, also known as card sleeves, are thin, **transparent protective sleeves** that protect your cards from scratches, fingerprints and dirt. They are the first step in keeping cards safe and an absolute must-have for every collector. Ideal for everyday protection or as a basis for other protective sleeves such as toploaders.

2. Top loader – Stability and protection against damage

Toploaders are **rigid plastic sleeves** that not only protect cards from scratches, but also from creases and light impacts. They are popular for more valuable cards. Use them to store or send valuable cards securely in the long term. The cards should be inserted into the toploader with a sleeve to maximise protection.



3. Magholder – Perfection for the premium collection

Magholders (magnetic cases) are sturdy, transparent plastic boxes that enclose cards perfectly. Thanks to a magnetic closure, they are easy to open and offer excellent protection. Their elegant design makes them ideal for presenting particularly valuable cards. Ideal for high-priced or rare cards that you want to display securely and stylishly at the same time.

Important: all accessories are available in different sizes and qualities - for the Panini PDC Premier League Darts Collection the regular/standard articles for a thickness of up to 35pt are the right choice.

4. Collection folders – For the perfect collection

A collection folder with matching insert pages is the centre-piece of many Collections. It allows you to organise your cards clearly and thematically and offers a practical way of putting together a collection that is as complete as possible. Use a collection folder to organise cards by set, theme or rarity. Combine it with high-quality sleeves to ensure additional protection inside the sleeves.



For maximum security and clarity, many collectors combine all of these products for an optimal presentation of the entire collection.

TRADING-CARD-GRADING

For professional collectors and anyone who wants to become one!

Trading card grading is a standardised process in which a trading card is checked for authenticity and condition. The aim is to achieve a comprehensible condition grade - usually on a scale from 1 (badly damaged) to 10 (near gem-mint) - and to seal it securely in a transparent plastic case ("slab") with a label and serial number.

The first step is to check the authenticity: the card must not show any signs of forgery, trimming, retouching or repairs. If the card is genuine and original, it is then assessed precisely according to four key criteria:

- **Centring:** The image should be aligned as symmetrically as possible to the centre of the card (ideally approx. 50/50; slightly deviating up to 60/40 is acceptable)
- **Corners:** Sharp, undamaged corners without signs of wear such as rounding or white spots are crucial for a high grade
- **Edges:** Card edges must be clean and without abrasion or fraying. Whitening or frayed cut edges also lower the rating
- **Surface:** Scratches, dust, print lines, colour errors or imprints impair the visible quality and significantly reduce the overall impression

The card is then sealed in a dust-tight plastic case with a label and serial number - often supplemented by digital archiving of the assessment. The result is a transparent valuation that can be traded, compared and reproduced.

A particularly practical effect of this grading approach: If you want to have a card graded yourself for your own collection, the external grading gives you a neutral assessment. At the same time, the card is protected in the long term: the sealed case protects it from environmental influences, mechanical wear and improper handling. This protects it from physical damage as well as light and air damage and allows it to be stored safely in your personal collection for the long term.

If you want to sell a card from your collection, professional grading provides an independent condition assessment that both buyers and sellers can trust.
